# Strengths

- CEIAG is a pervasive element of the school's pupil centred culture. All pupils are supported in identifying their individual skills and aspirations and provided with learning environments and activities where they can be developed. Differentiation is a core concept in ensuring this works for all pupils.
- CEIAG is supported by the senior management team, who recognise it as integral for the success of their pupils.
- Pupils take part in a range of work related activities often involving interactions with employers both on and off the school site.
- Significant elements of the CEIAG programme are provided by a Connexions PA. All
  pupils receive impartial progression guidance and support to help them understand the
  world of work and move into suitable post 16 opportunities.
- The 'pupil voice' is prominent across all areas of delivery in the school, and feedback is routinely collected around CEIAG.

That the Quality in Careers Standard be awarded.

# **Development Points**

- Greater alignment of the CEIAG curriculum across the two school units to ensure a smoother transition for pupils from Braybrook to Midpoint.
- Provision of more employer based experiences for pupils through the development of half-day work placements.
- Overhaul of the school's website.
- Development of the 'careers champions' initiative (unit I).
